**2009 OPEN CLASS BEEF SHOW**

**DIRECTOR: Joe Goins**

1. Animals may be brought in any time *Tuesday, July 28, 2009*, between the hours of 9:00 am and 9:00 pm. (If not in by 5:00 PM the gate fee must be paid.)
2. Animals exhibited in the open class at the Marion County Fair need not obtain health papers as in the past. The required paper has been replaced by the "Premise ID Number" issued by the IBAH. Please write your "Premise ID Number" on the appropriate blank on the entry form.  
**Entries cannot be accepted without the Premise ID number.**
3. Registration papers must be presented for each animal before showing.
4. Barn space, tie-outs and wash rack are furnished. The exhibitor must furnish all other needs, including drinking buckets.
5. Class ages are based on standard classification. See next paper for class breakdowns and premium list.
6. Entries may be made until 6 pm. Weds. *July 29, 2009*, at the fee of \$3 per head. Stall fee should be sent to:

**Check or money order made payable to Marion County Fair must accompany all Entries.**
7. Stalls will be assigned to all paid entries, on a first come, first served basis. Stalls must be cleaned before leaving the premises or premium money will be withheld. The Fair Board of Directors will designate a location for refuse.
8. No exhibitor shall be paid premiums for more than two entries in each class.
9. Beef cattle will show *Wednesday, July 29, 2009*, starting at approximately 8:30 PM immediately after the 4-H show.
10. Beef cattle will be released two hours after completion of show.
11. Premium money will be paid on single entries if judge decides it is a quality animal(s).
12. REGISTERED CROSSBRED HEIFER CLASSES will be offered should there be ample entries. Class time to be assigned by the director. If a class is scratched due to insufficient entries, entry fees for that class will be refunded. This pertains to Registered Heifer classes.
