1. Animals exhibited in the open class at the Marion County Fair need not obtain health papers as in the past. The required paper has been replaced by the "Premise ID Number" issued by the IBAH. Please write your Premise ID number on the appropriate blank on the entry form.  
**Entries cannot be accepted without the Premise ID number.**
2. Entries will be taken the date of the show between 8 AM – noon.  
An exhibitor may have any number of entries per class.
3. a. Entry fee(s) are \$10.00 per animal and  
b. Fees must be paid at the time of making entries

## GILT AND BARROW SHOW INFORMATION

**Purebred Hogs** - Purebred Gilt and Barrow Classes will be provided for the following breeds:

(note – breeds of four(4) or less will be exhibited as All Other Breeds (AOB))

**ALL Purebred Gilts must have registration papers available.**

### **GILT SHOW**

1. Purebred Gilts will be shown by Date of Birth as follows:
  - a. January 2009
  - b. February 2009
  - c. March 2009
2. All other Purebreds – Breeds with four or less per breed will be shown in an All Other Breeds (AOB) Class by age or weight.
3. Crossbred Gilts will be weighed and shown by weight only. Weight classes will be divided as even as practical.

### **BARROW SHOW**

1. Barrows of any breed or cross may be exhibited. **270-pound maximum weight limit.**
2. Weight classes will be established by first weighing all barrows and dividing them into weight classes as even as practical.
3. Each breed with five or more barrows will have its own class.
4. Breeds with four or less per breed will be shown in an All Other Breeds (AOB) Class.
