GENERAL RULES

1. Entry fee for all OPEN CLAS PIGEONS AND DOMESTIC RING-NECK DOVES is \$1.25 per bird, payable with entry. Make checks payable to **MARION COUNTY FAIR**.
2. Entries close July 20, 2010. Send entries to Don Glowinski, 3525 East Southport Road, Indianapolis, IN 46227
3. Classes will be made of old cock, old hen, young cock, and young hen.
4. Birds will be cooped between 10 AM and Noon, Sunday, July 25. **All birds must be in cages by Noon when the judging begins. NO BIRDS WILL BE COOPED PRIOR TO 10 AM SUNDAY, JULY 25.** Birds will be released at 4 PM provided all judging is completed.
5. Trophies may be awarded to Best Sporting, Best Fancy, Best Utility, and Best of Show. Other trophies may be presented in selected classes. Ribbons available for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places, but will not be mailed. Premiums will be \$1.25 for 1st; \$0.75 for 2nd, and \$0.50 for 3rd. No premium check will be issued for less than \$1.00. These checks will be mailed.
6. All rules that apply to all pigeon and dove shows will apply here. Classing will be done by the show secretary. Any questions, contact show secretary. Exhibition birds will include racing homers for show, show rollers, American Show Racers, German Beauty Homers, show flights, show tipplers, etc.

State on entry if your bird is sporting or exhibition, if applicable.
7. Marion County Fair will provide sale cages to exhibitors at no charge. Limit on sale birds is 50 per loft. Sale cages are limited to pigeon and doves **ONLY!**
8. We need trophies/prizes donated! Anyone wishing to donate toward purchase of trophies/awards in specific breeds, contact show secretary. Breed and loft exhibits are allowed and encouraged.
9. Enter the fairgrounds through Gate 5 on Fisher Road. The Poultry/Rabbit Building is nearby. Tell the gate attendant that you are bringing in show birds.
10. **All birds must be free from infectious disease and free from external parasites.**
