***** GENERAL RULES *****

1. Entry fee for all OPEN CLASS POULTRY and WATERFOWL is \$2.00 per bird, due with entry. Send payment with entry form. Please make check or money order payable to **MARION COUNTY FAIR.**
2. Any Marion County 4-H member exhibiting in both the 4-H Poultry project and in Open Class Poultry or Waterfowl will have a special entry fee of \$1.00 per bird.
3. **Entry deadline: Friday, July 9, 2010.** Send entries to Don Glowinski, P.O. Box 39225, Indianapolis, IN 46239. It must be postmarked by July 9, 2010. *No late entries accepted.*
4. **Judging: Tuesday, July 27, 10:00 a.m.** 4-H showmanship is first, followed by 4-H poultry judging then open class poultry judging. This is Danish, not placing, judging.
5. Classes will be based on the standards set forth by 4-H. Mark ALL entries whether Standard or Bantam and the variety.
6. **Poultry check-in: Friday, July 23, 7:00 to 9:00 p.m.;** east entrance of poultry barn; gate 5 on Fisher Road
Poultry check-out: Wednesday, July 28, 5:00 to 9:00 p.m.
7. No chickens, turkeys, or game birds will be allowed in the poultry barn unless documents demonstrating that birds originated from a National Poultry Improvement Plan (NPIP) certified pullorum-typhoid clean flock or have a negative pullorum-typhoid test within ninety (90) days preceding exhibition are presented at the check-in table. **Please complete and bring the enclosed form to check-in.** We plan on having testing at fair check-in.
8. No poultry may be exhibited showing signs of infectious or communicable disease or excessive signs of external parasite infestation.
9. **Premiums: Grand Champion - \$10 Reserve Grand Champion - \$8**
\$4 for each of the following Champions: Standard Pullet, Standard Cockerel, Standard Hen, Standard Cock, Bantam Pullet, Bantam Cockerel, Bantam Hen and Bantam Cock.
****Please see the Director, Don Glowinski, to get your premium money before you take home your birds.**
10. Exhibitors must provide their own **durable** feed and water containers. All containers must be securely wired to the cage or be heavy enough so the bird will not tip it over. Bedding will be provided.
11. **You must provide your own feed.** Leave it under one of your cages in a container with your name on it. We will be feeding and watering in the evening only. The 4-H members will be caring for the birds.
